- The Zion Endowment Fund is a means whereby the ministry of the congregation can effectively witness to the love of God for those in the community and beyond. The fund is made possible by the generous bequest and gifts of those who wish to share their blessings with the church. Income generated by the Zion endowment fund provides ongoing support for church-related activities, programs and secular causes which reflect the Lord's love for mankind and to share our rich blessings by making grants to support the outreach ministry of Zion.
- Applicants need to complete the required request form which is available at the church office and the Loudonville Public Library.
- Timeline
  - Applications are due to church office by noon, October 24
  - Committee reviews all submitted requests and prepares a recommended distribution list. This is completed by the end of November.
  - Congregation votes on the recommendation by January 31.
  - Checks will be disbursed by early February.
- The Bylaws of the Zion Endowment Fund provides for grant requests in four areas:
  1. Requests related directly to the Christian outreach ministry of Zion Lutheran Church
  2. Requests related to non-church programs (such as Habitat for Humanity, Helping Hands, etc.) which would witness to God's message of salvation through faith in Jesus Christ.
  3. Requests related to donations of a personal nature.
  4. Requests involving monetary gifts, purchase of property, construction, equipment, or any additional to the physical assets of Zion Lutheran Church of Loudonville.
